### STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

### **Governing Document**

The charity is controlled by its governing document, the Memorandum and Articles of Association dated 24th June 2012 and amended 10th September 2012.

### Organisation

The trustees meet three times a year to administer the charity. Trustees are recruited to enhance its skills by advertising.

The Trust has delegated powers to one group, the User Group and appoints a caretaker who is also a Trustee.

User Group – meets annually to provide a forum to produce an annual report to the trust which includes a review of the health and safety policy. The group is led by a trustee and includes a minimum of two further trustees.

Caretaker – has total accountability for the upkeep of all aspects of the Pavilion and sits on the User Group as the forum for discussing, improving and monitoring all aspects including health and safety.

### **Risk Management**

The trustees have a duty to identify and review the risks to which the charity is exposed and to ensure appropriate controls are in place to provide reasonable assurance against fraud and error.

#### **OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES**

### **Objectives and aims**

The objective of the Trust is to provide a venue that will unite the villages of Nettlestone and Seaview through sport, recreation and social activities. This involved the demolition of condemned buildings on Seaview Recreation Ground. The buildings consisted of Seaview F C changing rooms, 1st Seaview guide hut, a public toilet block and a tea hut.

### **Administration of Pavilion Hire**

As the UK moves to a position of greater normality after a great deal of disruption due to COVID, the economic bounce back seems to involve a rise in inflation. In order to support the Pavilion Users during the restrictions, the trustees had waived fees for a time. As we move into our tenth year, Trustees are mindful that maintenance may require a larger slice of the budget. Accordingly, for the first time in 8 years, an increase in charges was voted through at the December meeting. This does not impact on our core of regular community users, but commercial and one off users.

New Fees: Regular Community Users: £6 per hour (£8 if using extensive kitchen facilities). Commercial Users: £12 per hour (£15 if using extensive kitchen facilities). One off Hire: £15 per hour, with full kitchen use.

### One off Hire

These are continuing to be a useful Community Resource. The Pavilion was used for the Parish Council and Police Commissioner Elections in May 2021. With additional signage and a smaller turnout than the General Election of the previous year, this was a successful use of the Pavilion.

### **Stated Aim**

Our stated aim continues to be to encourage community engagement by providing a venue for local groups to meet and undertake recreational activity.

However, 2021 was another difficult year nationally. In spite of the extensive vaccination programme, our local demographic was cautious about meeting up and enjoying the activities offered at the Pavilion. Nevertheless, there were successes; the Men-in-Sheds which the Trust continues to work with, now have their own premises; the Bridge and Seaview Fun Choir have maintained good numbers while Seaview Football Club now has a Walking Football Group. The Community has also increased its use of the Pavilion for small parties. In addition, the Pavilion has become a regular venue for Parish Council or Parish Planning meetings.

As Seagrove Pavilion moves into its 10th year of operation, it is well placed to continue to play a significant role in bringing the local community together.

### **Continuing Celebration of Achievement**

The Chairman and Trustees are immensely grateful to the whole community for their continued support of this valued community facility.

I report on the accounts for the Year Ended 31 December 2021 set out on pages eight to sixteen.

### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

### **Accounting Convention**

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008), the Companies Act 2006 and the requirements of the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities.

### **Incoming Resources:**

All incoming resources are included on the Statement of Financial Activities when the charity is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy.

### **Resources Expended:**

Expenditure is accounted for on an cash basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

### **Tangible Fixed Assets:**

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Land and buildings:

- Straight line over 25 years

Plant and machinery etc.:

- Straight line over 4 years

### **Taxation:**

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

### **Fund Accounting:**

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
